

Leaving Your Regiment

Leaving a regiment is common and everyone below the rank of Corporal has a right to leave their regiment whenever they please.

If a person is between the ranks of Corporal-MSGT (NCOs), they need permission from their HICOM to leave, they may be denied leave for up to 1 week, after which the HICOM must let them leave.

If a person is a commissioned officers (Lieutenant - Lieutenant Colonel), they need permission from the Colonel of their regiment. The colonel may deny permission to discharge for up to 2 weeks, given a logical reason, after which they must let them leave.

If a person has held a rank in their regiment or CA for 2+ weeks. They may not be demoted for leaving the regiment.

In a situation where it is evident that there has been an action for recruiting for another regiment using a sort of bribery or motive for speed-ranking or free-ranking, if the person chose to switch their regiment, the person of whom is trying to recruit the other person will be reported for corruption. This also applies if someone convinces another to abandon their regiment.

Newly commissioned officers must serve one month in their commissioned regiment before transferring, otherwise they may face decommission upon leaving.

In the event someone asks to leave then changes their mind, their old request to leave will be invalidated and they will have to request to leave again.

When requesting to leave your regiment, you must do so through Discord chat to prevent any miscommunication. Failure to do so will result in your request not counting and your timer will reset.

Leaving your regiment without following the rules that have been set by your Brigadier General or your Commanding General will result in a demotion to Militia and a Treason report.
